

Seeking Dementia Care Specialists for FREE training to build community & reduce loneliness

The Creative Care Institute for Dementia Care Specialists (DCSs) offers TimeSlips evidence-based training and certification to DCSs in Wisconsin. This training shares innovative communication techniques that allow for more enriching care partnerships between people with memory loss and those who care for them.

This opportunity also includes useful resources to support family caregivers, professional development opportunities meant for DCSs, and some of our newest resources, focused on reducing social isolation through remote engagement.

Why should I participate in this opportunity?

This opportunity is catered specifically to Wisconsin-based Dementia Care Specialists. There are many incentives for participating, including:

- Completing the TimeSlips training and certification can count towards required DHS evidence-based program requirement
- Get ideas of how to reduce loneliness that elders and caregivers may be experiencing in your community
- Access to TimeSlips Certified Trainers who will provide professional development opportunities including webinars covering an array of topics such as using TimeSlips in Memory Cafe settings, and using our method remotely
- Shareable resources for your network of family care partners, including TimeSlips monthly virtual gatherings
- Participate in an artistic initiative, that shares the voices of Wisconsin elders and their care partners, statewide
- You will receive 25 Imagination Kits

What is expected of me in order to participate?

We have training components that require a minimal amount of time and have a high degree of support. There are also additional learning opportunities which will happen in cohorts with other DCSs in your region. This project will begin engaging DCSs in training on or after October 31st, 2022, and will provide a two year membership with TimeSlips.

By participating in this project, you will be expected to:

- Complete online TimeSlips
 Training and Certification
 (about six hours in total, all online, at your own pace)
 between October 31st, 2022 and March 3rd, 2023
- Participate in minimal evaluational surveys, provided for this project by the Medical College of Wisconsin
- Share our free Friends & Family resources with your caregiver networks
- Attend webinars (or watch recordings) that are hosted by TimeSlips, made specifically with this audience in mind.
