Our Creative Campus customized training is specifically designed for educational partners. Our online tools and remote coaching are designed to help you build an experience for your students that will aid in breaking down negative stereotypes between young people and elders as well as reduce the stigma around aging and neurodiversity. Secondly, we aim for these experiences to be a launching point for students who have an interest in pursuing a career in the field of aging, community arts/development or who want to broaden the scope of their career.

### Who gets trained and what do they learn?



### What is included in a Creative Campus?

- Certification for six Staff / Faculty (typically \$350 per person)
- Unlimited training for students
- Free option to become a Lead Trainer who can certify students
- Coaching services by the TimeSlips Program Manager
  - who has many years in youth programming
- A toolkit that has practical, editable tools
- A Student Artist-in-Residence (or SAIR) training program. In partnership with an aging services partner, your school will place a student in residence and will conduct creative engagement programming with elders with mentorship from both their instructor and the staff of the aging services partner.
- Creative engagement support on how to implement large scale creative engagement projects
- Networking with the larger, global team of Certified TimeSlips Facilitators and Master Trainers who work in a wide variety of fields.

### What Does it Cost?

The initial cost of a Creative Campus membership is \$2,500. That is half the cost of our All Access Organizational membership.

There is an annual renewal fee of \$1,250 to maintain your Creative Campus status and the ability to continue inviting new students to the training.

Note about payment: some schools have split the cost across departments or written a grant using our supporting materials.



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
